Ministry of External Affairs invites applications from the Retired Section Officers (SOs) of Ministry of External Affairs(MEA) for engagement on contract basis as Section Officers(SO) in Ministry of External Affairs(MEA) as under:

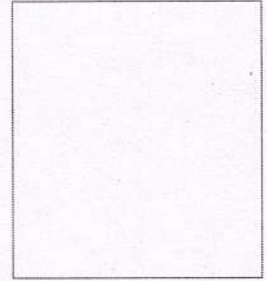

Terms & Conditions

1 Period of engagement

The term of engagement shall ordinarily be for an initial period not exceeding one year which is extendable by another one year. Engagement on contract basis will be subject to filling of the vacant posts against whom Retired Section Officers have been hired by the Promoted Officials of the Ministry. Beyond two years after the age of superannuation where adequate justification exists, the term may be extended based on a review of the task and the performance of the contract appointee, provided it shall not be extended beyond 5 years after superannuation.

- **No Extension will be granted beyond the age of 65 years.**

2 Selection Procedure

The engagement will be purely on contract basis. Application received in response to this advertisement will be shortlisted on the basis of experience and qualification of applicants. Section Officer(Retired) will be selected by a Selection Committee from shortlisted candidates and will be hired on contract basis in MEA.

- **MEA reserves the right to reject any application without mentioning any reason.**

3 Remuneration

A fixed monthly amount shall be admissible, arrived at by deducting the basic pension from the pay drawn at the time of retirement. The basic pension to be deducted from the last pay drawn shall be the pension as fixed at the time of retirement and as such, if the employee has availed of the commuted value of pension, the commuted portion of pension shall also be included in the portion of pension to be deducted. The amount of remuneration so fixed shall remain unchanged for the term of contract and there will be no annual increment / percentage increase during the contract period. No DA/HRA, residential accommodation shall be admissible.

4 Transport Allowance

An appropriate and fixed amount as Transport Allowance for the purpose of commuting between the residence and the place of work shall be allowed not exceeding the rate applicable to the appointee at the time of retirement. Such Travelling allowance will be as per his/her entitlement wrt 7th CPC level in which s/he superannuated. The amount so fixed shall remain unchanged during the term of engagement. However, retired SOs engaged on contract basis may be allowed TA/DA on official tour, if any, as per their entitlement at the time of retirement. No TA/DA is admissible for joining the assignment or on its completion.

5 Leave

The Retired SOs hired on contract basis will be entitled to the paid leave at the rate of 1.5 days for each complete month of service. Accumulation of leave beyond calendar year may not be allowed. In special circumstances, the Section Officer(Retired) engaged on contract basis could be called for services on holidays or beyond normal working hours for which no extra remuneration will be paid.

6 Scope of Duties

During the period of such engagement, the Section Officer(Retired) would be required to perform the duties as assigned by the Head of Division.

7 Tax deduction at Source

The Income Tax or any other tax liable to be deducted, as per the prevailing rules will be deducted at source before effecting the payment for which the office will issue TDS certificate.

8 Office time and working hours

Engagement of Section Officer(Retired) on contract basis would be on full time basis. Working hours shall be from 9.00 AM to 5.30 PM during working days including half an hour lunch break in between. They will not be allowed to take any other assignment during the period of contractual engagement. The Section Officer(Retired) may be called on Saturday/Sunday/other Gazetted holidays, if required.

9 Confidentiality of data and documents

The Retired SOs shall sign an agreement of confidentiality with the Government of India containing a clause on Ethics and Integrity.

The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of the data collected as well as the deliverables produced for the office shall remain with this office. No one shall utilize or publish or disclose or part with, to a third party, any part of the data or statistics or proceedings or information collected for the purpose of this assignment or during the course of the assignment for the office, without the express written consent of the office. The Section Officer(Retired) on contract basis shall be bound to hand over the entire set of records of assignment to the office before the expiry of the contract, and before the final payment is released by the office.

10 Conflict of interest

The Section Officer(Retired) engaged by this office, shall in no case represent or give opinion or advice to others in any matter which is adverse to the interest of this office. No Section Officer(Retired) would be permitted to take up any other assignment during the period of their contract with the MEA.

11 Termination of service

The engagement may be terminated at any time on immediate basis by the office without assigning any reasons. In case, the Section Officer(Retired) engaged on contract basis desires to leave the assignment, he/she is to give 07 day's notice which can be curtailed/extended depending upon the workload. Similarly, Employer(the Ministry) will give 07 days notice to the employee before termination. The engagement will be purely on contract basis and can be terminated as and when the vacant posts against whom Retired Section Officers have been hired will be filled by the promoted Officials in the Ministry and in the event of such termination, the employee will be liable to refund the excess payment if any made to him/her over and above what is due in terms of this contract. If at the time of termination, payment is due to the employee for services already rendered; such payments will be made to him.

➤ **In the event any Section Officer(Retired) is found unfit on any account or if he/she is found guilty of any insubordination/misconduct, his/her services can be terminated immediately without any notice.**

12 MEA shall not be responsible for any loss, accident, damage; injury suffered by the Section Officer(Retired) whatsoever arising in or out of the execution of his work including travel.

13 DISPUTE SETTLEMENT

Any dispute or difference regarding the interpretation of the provisions of this agreement shall be resolved amicably between the parties. If the dispute is not resolved amicably, either party may refer the dispute or difference to Additional Secretary (AD) or his nominee, Ministry of External Affairs and whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties.

14 Guidelines for the submission of the application

The duly completed application in prescribed proforma should be submitted so as to reach the office latest by 26/04/2023. Any application received after the above date will not be entertained. The application should be submitted with the following documents:-

- e) Copy of PAN card and AADHAR card- mandatory
- f) Copy of last two years' APARs
