Please refer to your RTI application which was received in this Ministry on 10 May 2019.

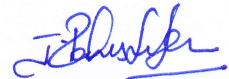
2. The response to your RTI application is as follows:

Government of India had taken several efforts for the listing of Masood Azhar, leader of JeM (Jaish-e-Mohammed) as a global terrorist under the UNSC Sanctions regime. India proposed listing of Masood Azhar by the UN Security Council Sanctions Committee in March 2009. China's objection led to deletion of our request from the consideration of the Committee. In February 2016, India once again requested for listing of Masood Azhar, which was blocked by China in December 2016.

India had been constantly following up with the United Nations on the listing of Masood Azhar. Besides, the Government took up the issue during several bilateral/ multilateral discussions with several countries including China, France, Russia, UK, US, etc at various levels of diplomatic engagement.
