Sub: - Petition under Right to Information Act, 2005.

We would like to introduce ourselves as one of the pioneers in rendering free legal aid to the economically downtrodden Indian nationals who are working abroad. In this context it is pertinent to point out that many of our brothers and sisters who fly overseas in search of greener pastures meet with tragic road, rail, ship and other fatal accidents either at their workplace or in the course of or out of employment. These brothers are not men of letters and do not know even the basic legal procedure to claim compensation from their employers who try to hoodwink them by hook or crook. It is for them that we also cater to many of our investors abroad who have miserably failed in retrieving their hard earned money lying in the coffers of other countries. I would therefore request you to kindly divulge the following information under Sec.6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 at the earliest and oblige:

- 1) Please furnish the names of the Indians who have returned to India due to injuries, death etc., arising out of their employment abroad in the recent past, that is, seven years hence and their full address?
- 2) Kindly furnish the names of Indian nationals who have met with any sort of accidents abroad and the complete details of the mishap etcetera, the nature of injury, grievous wound & are still working there?
- 3) Has the Ministry of external affairs extended the olive branch to these poor Indians who have been deported for very obvious reasons best known to their employees in foreign countries after finding them unfit for further employment at their workplace?
