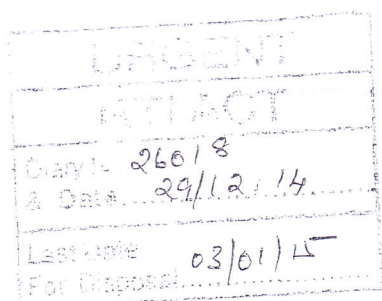


4. Current status of the MoUs is as follows:
