Condolence message of President of India to President of Tunisia on the terror attack in Sousse

His Excellency Mr. Pranab Mukherjee, President of India, in a message to His Excellency Mr. Beji Caid Essebsi, President of the Republic of Tunisia, expressed the shock and sadness with which he had learned of the horrific terrorist attack' in Tunisia and conveyed his heartfelt condolences and the deepest sympathies of the government and people of India. He went on to state that their thoughts and prayers were with the families of those who had lost their lives and also expressed sincere wishes for the speedy recovery of the injured.

India strongly condemnrd all acts of terror and senseless violence and believed that the progress of humanity lay in unity, peace, brotherhood and non-violence. President Mukherjee affirmed that India stood by the people of Tunisia in this difficult hour and reaffirmed India's commitment to the global efforts against terrorism.

The letter to President Essebsi ended with a prayer for peace in Tunisia as well as the progress and prosperity of its people.
