<u>Visit of Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Minister of State for Finance & Corporate Affairs</u> to Kenya (5-8 March, 2017)

Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, the Minister of State for Finance & Corporate Affairs, Government of India is on a visit to Kenya from 5-8 March, 2017. He will be representing the Prime Minister of India at the 4th Annual Devolution Conference taking place in Nakuru County.

2. On 6th March, the Minister visited the Bank of India's Head Office located at the





Kenyatta Avenue, Nairobi in an heritage building which used to be the Kenya National Assembly and interacted with the Bank officials. He also received and interacted with a delegation of Indian diaspora hailing from the State of Rajasthan.
