## Government of India releases cheques worth of Rs./Nu. 1901.209 million for Project Tied Assistance Projects



Mrs. Esha Srivastava, Deputy Chief of Mission, Indian Embassy, handed over cheques amounting to Rs./Nu. 1901.209 million (Rs./Nu. 97.64 million for Gol Project Tied Assistance projects, Rs./Nu. 425 million for Programme Grant and Rs./Nu. 1378.569 million for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Batch of Small Development Project) to Dasho Thinley Namgyal, Secretary GNHC on 23 May, 2017.

This release of funds of worth Rs./Nu. 1901.209 million will fund (1) Development of Infrastructure & Teaching, Jigme Namgyel Polytechnic (2) Development of Infrastructure & Teaching, College of Science & Technology (3) Development of Infrastructure & Teaching, Samtse College of Education (4) 15th Installment of Development Subsidy (Programme Grant) for the period January-March 2017 and (5) 3<sup>rd</sup> Batch of Small Development Project (i.e. 2<sup>nd</sup> Installment).

Government of India has committed Nu. 50,000 million as grant assistance to the 11<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan of the Royal Government of Bhutan. The detailed break-up of the commitment is: Rs./Nu. 28,000 million for Project Tied Assistance (PTA), Rs./Nu. 8,500 million for Program Grant (PG),

Rs./Nu. 8,500 million for Small Development Projects (SDP) and Rs./Nu. 8,500 million for Economic Stimulus Plan.

As on date, Government of India has released Rs./Nu. 17028 million for GoI PTA projects, Rs./Nu. 6375 million for Program Grant, Rs./Nu. 7150 million for SDP and Rs./Nu. 4400 million for Economic Stimulus Plan to RGoB. In total, GoI has released Rs./Nu. 34953 million to RGoB which is 70 % of the total GOI commitment for the 11th Five Year Plan Period.
