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E-NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)

- Online bids are invited from authorized suppliers for Supply of Brass name plates. National Emblems and Car Pennant to our Indian Missions/Posts abroad.
- 2 The two bid system (Technical and Financial) shall be followed for this tender. The bid (complete in all respect) shall be submitted online only at Central Public Procurement Portal Website: http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app. Manual bids will not be accepted under any circumstances.

3 Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:-

- 3.1 The bidder shall be Authorised distributor/Supplier/dealer of the item covered under this tender. A valid proof of such authorization from the manufacturing company has to be compulsorily attached with the technical bid;
- 3.2 The bidder shall have minimum 2 years of experience of supplying item covered under this tender in bulk to the Departments/Ministries/organisation of the Government of India/State Govt./PSU (Valid proof has to be attached);
- 3.3 The bidder shall have minimum turnover of Rs. 6,00,000/- per annum during each of the last two years. Attested copies of income tax returns must be submitted with the technical bid;
- 3.4 The bidder shall not have been blacklisted by any of the Departments/Ministries/organisation of the Government of India. A duly signed undertaking to this effect must be submitted with the technical bid;
- 3.5 The bidder should possess valid GST registration. Attested copies of the same must be submitted with the technical bid;

4 Submission of online bids:-

- 4.1 The bid shall be submitted online only at Central Public Procurement Portal Website: http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app
 Manual bids will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 4.2 The online bids (complete in all respect) must be uploaded online in Two Covers (Technical and Financial bids) as explained in Annexure-I.
- 4.3 Tenderer/Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the 'Instruction to Tenderer' specified at Annexure-V of this Tender document for esubmission of the bids online through Central Public Procurement Portal Website: http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app before proceeding with the tender;
- 4.4 All documents as per tender requirement shall be uploaded online through Central Public Procurement Portal Website: http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app and further no documents will be accepted offline.
- 4.5 Bidders not submitting any of the required documents online will be summarily rejected;
- 4.6 Both technical and financial bid are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed on the Central Public Procurement Portal;
- 4.7 The bidders shall have a valid digital signature certificate for participation in the online tender. The cost of digital signatures, if any, will be borne by respective tenderer;
- 4.8 Prospective bidders are accordingly advised to go through instructions provided at Central Public Procurement Portal;
- 4.9 Bid security Declaration in the prescribed format as mentioned in Annexure-IV is to be sumbitted online along with the bids.
- 5 Financial Bid:-The bidder must submit their financial bid in the prescribed format (BOQ.XXXX File) – specified at Annexure II of this tender document and no other format is acceptable. Bidders are required to download the BOQ File, open it and

complete the unprotected cells with their respective financial quotes [the rate per unit for each item in both figures and words (without GST)] and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the file name. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected. The bidders are strictly advised to refrain from quoting unrealistic prices at which they may not make supplies later.

6 Critical Dates:- Given in page no. 1 of the Tender document

7 Extension of last date at the Discretion of the Ministry:-The Ministry may in its discretion extend the last date for e-submission of the online bids and such extension shall be binding on all the Bidders. Addendum/Corrigendum, if any in this regard, will be published on the Ministry of External Affairs' website: www.mea.gov.in and Central Public Procurement Portal Website: http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app

8 Opening of Technical Bid & Financial Bid:-

- 8.1 Online bids (complete in all respect) received along with Bid Security Declaration will be opened as per stipulated time and date indicated in para 6 of the tender document in presence of bidders representative, if available at Room No. 4009, A Wing, 4th Floor Jawaharlal Nehru Bhawan, 23-D Janpath, New Delhi-110011. Bid received without BID SECURITY DECLARATION will be rejected straightaway;
- 8.2 A duly constituted committee will evaluate eligibility criteria of bidders.
- 8.3 Technical bid of only those bidders, whose bids are declared eligible by the committee, will be evaluated.
- 8.4 It shall be noted that required documents submitted online along with the technical bid will be perused/examined and in case of any deficiency, the technical bid will be rejected and financial bid will not be opened;
- 8.5 During the opening of technical bids, bidders are required to <u>bring along with</u> them a sample 16 inch X 16 inch brass sheet with national emblem etched on it.
- 8.6 After scrutiny of technical bids, the Ministry shall shortlist the eligible bidders and inform them of the date and time of opening of the Financial Bids (Preferably by E-mail);
- 8.7 The representatives of the bidders willing to attend tender opening process will have to submit a letter of authorisation to this effect;
- 8.8 In case the date of opening of tender is declared a holiday for unexpected reasons, the tender shall be opened same time on the next working day;
- 8.9 Bids shall be summarily rejected, if it is received other than online through Central Public Procurement Portal;
- 9 Validity of Bid:- The bids shall be valid for a period of four months from the date of opening of bids. A bid for a shorter period of validity shall stand rejected;

10 Bid Prices and period of their validity:

Rates should be valid for one year from the date of signing of the agreement. Rates prices should remain fixed during the entire period of the contract. i.e. one year shall not be subject to variation on any account. However, in case of fall in the benefit shall be passed on to the Ministry. No claim for compensation loss due to fluctuations or any other reasons / causes shall be entertained. A bid with an adjustable price quotation shall be treated as non responsive and be rejected. No request for increase in the rates would be entertained during period of contract.

- 10.2 The Annual Rate Contract (ARC) shall initially be on annual basis of one year. However, the ARC may be extended for further period of one year with mutual agreement on the same rate, terms and conditions, if the services of the contractor are satisfactory.
- 11 Non transferability:-This tender is non-transferable. The incomplete and conditional tenders will be summarily rejected;
- 12 Non-withdrawal of Bids:- No bidders will be allowed to withdraw after e-submission of bids/ opening of the tender, otherwise necessary action will be taken against the Bidder as per Bid Security Declaration submitted by the firm.

13 Basis of awarding the contract:-

The contract shall be awarded on the basis of the lowest quote for each item.

- 13.1 If two or more bidders have offered the same rate, the Ministry reserves the right to classify all such bidders as lowest and divide the purchase order suitably between them.
- 13.2 During the period, no request for increase in quoted rates shall be accepted under any circumstances;

14 Purchasers Rights:-

- 14.1 Ministry reserves the right to accept/reject any or all the Bids in whole or in part and annul the bidding process without assigning any reason whatsoever;
- 14.2 Ministry reserves the right to award the supply orders in parts to more than one Bidder;
- 14.3 Ministry reserves the right to relax/withdraw any of the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender Document so as to overcome any problem encountered during the selection of the bidders and also during the course of the execution of the contract;
- 14.4 Ministry reserves the right to black list a bidder for a suitable period in case the firm fails to honour its bid without sufficient grounds;
- 14.5 If a firm after award of the contract violates any of the terms and conditions, it shall be blacklisted and its performance guarantee shall be forfeited;
- 14.6 An indicative list of items, with their particulars and detailed specifications, to be supplied under the proposed Annual Rate Contract is provided in Annexure III of the Tender Document;
- 14.7 It shall in no way be binding on the Ministry to purchase the exact number of quantities as indicated in Annexure II of the Tender Document. The actual quantities that may be purchased by the Ministry may vary in each case;

15 Delivery & Penalty for delayed services:-

- 15.1 The items (Brass Name Plates, National Emblems, Car Pennant) duly inspected. against all the orders received by the successful bidder will be delivered to SPM Section of this Ministry as early as possible but not later than 30 days from the date of issue of the orders. No separate transportation charges shall be payable on this account.
- 15.2 The supply of brass name plates, national emblems and car pennants is to be done at the following address:-

- 15.3 Liquidated damages: In case the bidder(s) fails to complete the order within the specified delivery period of 30 days, liquidated damages will be recovered from the bidders on slab basis i.e. ¼% of the price of the undelivered stores for the first month of part thereof ½% for second month, ¾ % for the third and subsequent months subject to a maximum of 2%
- 15.4 The bidder should keep a reasonable stock of car pennants.

16 Genuinity of the supplies :-

16.1 In case of any manufacturing defect of any shape/kind, the item shall have to be immediately replaced with a new one.

16.2 The supply shall be completed within the delivery (30 days) time as per Terms & Conditions of the Tender Document from the date of placement of Purchase Order.

17 Mode of Payment:

- 17.1 Payment against bill/Invoice shall be released only after execution of the supply order and if the quality of the items are found to the satisfaction of MEA.
- 17.2 Payment will be made by Indian Missions/Posts through SPM Section to the supplier by cheque. No request for other mode of payment will be entertained.
- 17.3 No advance payment will be made in any case.

18 Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):-

- 18.1 Successful Tenderer/suppliers will be required to submit a performance bank guarantee of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand only). at the time of signing of the agreement.
- 18.2 Bank guarantee shall be made in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi.
- 18.3 Bank guarantee should be valid for a period of 60 days from the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the contractor.
- 18.4 If successful Tenderer(s) fails to furnish the required bank guarantee at the specified time, the bidder will be barred from participating in future tenders of the Ministry.

19 Amendment of Bidding Document:-

- 19.1 At any time prior to the deadline for e-submission of bids, the Ministry may, for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to the clarification request by a prospective bidder, modify the bid document;
- Any amendment in the biding document, at any time prior to the deadline for esubmission of bids, shall be uploaded as "corrigendum" on
 http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app and www.mea.gov.in. Such amendments/
 modifications shall be binding on all the prospective bidders;
- 19.3 Ministry at its discretion may extend the deadline for the e-submission of bids if the bid document undergoes changes during the bidding period, in order to give prospective bidders time to take into the consideration the amendments while preparing their bids;
- 19.4 The Ministry reserves the right to amend or withdraw any of the terms and conditions contained in the tender document or to reject any or all the tenders in whole or in part without giving any notice or assigning any reason.

19.5 Further Addendum/Corrigendum if any will be uploaded onto website of MEA only besides the CPP portal. The decision of Ministry, in this regard, shall be final and binding on all.

20 Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices:-

- 20.1 It is expected that the bidders who wish to bid for this tender have highest standards of ethics;
- 20.2 Ministry shall reject bid if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices while competing for this contract;
- 20.3 Ministry may declare a bidder ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated duration, if it at any time determines that the bidder has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices during the execution of contract.

21 Force Majeure:-

- 21.1 Ministry may consider relaxing the penalty and delivery requirements, as specified in this Tender Document, if and to the extent the delay in performance or failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of a Force Majeure.
- 21.2 Force Majeure is defined as an event of effect that cannot reasonably be anticipated such as natural disasters, act of states, the direct and indirect consequences of wars (declared or undeclared), hostilities, national emergencies, civil commotion and strikes at successful bidders premise, etc.

22 Settlement of Disputes and Arbitration:-

- 22.1 All disputes, differences and questions arising out of or in any way touching or concerning this agreement or subject matter thereof or the representative rights, duties or liability of the parties shall be referred to the sole arbitration.
- 22.2 The arbitration shall be in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitrator shall be entitled to extend the time of arbitration proceedings with the consent of the parties.
- 22.3 No part of the agreement shall be suspended on the ground of pending arbitration proceedings.
- 22.4 The decision of the sole arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties.

23 Governing Laws and Disputes:-

23.1 Tender and the subsequent agreement with successful bidder shall be construed and governed by the Laws of the India and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Delhi Courts of Law.

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Annexure V Instruction to bidders

Instructions for Online Bid Submission:

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.

REGISTRATION

- Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrolment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- 2 As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3 Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4 Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / TCS / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6 Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- 1 There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3 The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

1 Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.

- Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- 4 To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" or "Other Important Documents" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload
 the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for
 any delay due to other issues.
- The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- Bidder should prepare the Bid Security Declaration as per the instructions specified in the tender document. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- 4. Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- 5. The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- 6. All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

- 8. Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (ie after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.
