1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The Accounts are prepared on the basis of Historical Cost Convention and generally on the accrual method of accounting except in case of CSCAP Grants and utilization thereof which are accounted for on cash basis.

2. FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

3. REVENUE RECOGNITION

- 3.1 Grants/ contributions received for specific purposes are initially treated as a liability and adjusted for capital or revenue expenses as per utilisation during a year.

He filed a court case against the termination and a lower court has passed an order directing ICWA to pay full back wages to the employee. Liability of `2.00 Lakhs on this account has not been provided for as ICWA has filed an appeal in Delhi High Court against the order of lower court. However on direction of the High Court, ICWA has deposited `1,01,205 with the Court which has been shown as advances in the balance sheet.

The Council is responsible for managing the grants only i.e. receipt of the grant and utilization thereof as per the specific sanction for each grant. The Council is of the view that project specific transactions have no bearing on surplus/ deficit of the Council and accordingly the same are accounted for on cash basis of accounting.
