Subject: Regarding transfer of Registration Certificate issued under the Emigration Act, 1983 to the legal heirs.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the issue relating to transfer of Registration Certificate issued under the Emigration Act, 1983 to the legal heirs raised during the meeting held on 5th June, 2013 under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister of Overseas Indian Affairs with the representatives of RAs Associations has been considered and a view has been taken that if the proprietor of the agency requests transfer of the Registration certificate in the name of his legal heir or a legal heir of the proprietor of the recruiting agency applies for grant of the existing RC to be issued in his name, this will be considered subject to the condition that the legal heir fulfils all requirements as per the Emigration Act/Rules and instructions, and if found to be eligible, a fresh Registration Certificate will be issued in the same title of the Agency.
