Celebrations of Gandhi@150

In continuation of celebration of Gandhi@150, the Mission organised a 'Tree Plantation Drive' on 3rd October 2020 with the support of Ministry of Agriculture, Water, Livestock, Fisheries and Marine Resources and Mayor of Djibouti. 150 saplings of Neem (Azadirachta Indica) tree are being planted to mark 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi at a public road, joining Avenue Nasser in Djibouti city stretching about 1.5 kilometers.

The Chief Guest of the event Ms. Fatouma Awaleh Osman, Hon'ble Mayor of Djibouti City along with Ambassador Shri Ashok Kumar and Mr. Ibrahim, Secretary General, Ministry of Agriculture and Mr. Wais Omar Bokore, Chief of Coast Guard, Djibouti inaugurated the Plantation Drive and planted the tree saplings.
