## Free medical camp for Indian community members at High Commission of India, Brunei Darussalam



The High Commission of India organized a free medical camp at the High Commission premises in Brunei Darussalam on Sunday, 19 March 2017 in collaboration with Gleneagles JPMC, the prestigious cardiac care centre of the country.

At the camp, paramedics administered basic medical tests, including for blood sugar, blood pressure and body mass index to Indian citizens, and thereafter doctors provided consultations to each of the Indian nationals in which they were advised on the lifestyle modifications necessary in view of their medical test results. In case any patients had test results of concern, they were asked to consult doctors at the Government-owned hospital, RIPAS.

At the end of the camp, Smt Nagma M Mallick, High Commissioner, and the doctors, which included cardiologists, an orthopedic specialist, a neurologist and an oncologist, conducted a question and answer session with the Indian citizens in which the doctors answered queries on health-related issues and High Commissioner provided details of the ongoing efforts of the High Commission to arrange reasonably-priced local medical insurance for Indian workers.

The medical camp was intended as a wake-up call to Indian citizens in Brunei Darussalam to engage in regular exercise, to adopt a healthy lifestyle and to get regular health screenings.

Around 230 Indian nationals got themselves tested. A team of six doctors and six paramedics provided services on a volunteer basis at the camp which was held from 8 am to 11 am.
