

## **India-Comoros Unclassified Bilateral Brief**

Comoros is an archipelagic country strategically located in the Mozambique Channel in the Indian Ocean between Madagascar and Mozambique. 98% of population of Comoros follow Shafi'i school of Sunni Islam. The commonly used languages are Shikomoro (Swahili dialect), French and Arabic.

2. India established diplomatic relations with Comoros in June 1976 and the Embassy of India in Antananarivo is concurrently accredited to Comoros. India and Comoros enjoy close and friendly relations. Both countries share similar views on several regional and multilateral issues of importance. Comoros is a member of the Indian Ocean Rim Association and also the International Solar Alliance.

3. President of Comoros H.E. Mr. Azali Assoumani took part in the G-20 Summit held in New Delhi on 9-10 September 2023, in his capacity as the then President of the African Union. He sent a video message for the 2nd edition of Voice of the Global South Summit chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in the virtual format on 17 November 2023. He also took part in the virtual G-20 Summit under the chairmanship of Prime Minister Modi on 22 November 2023. Minister of Interior and Acting Foreign Minister of Comoros H.E. Mr. Fakridine Mahamoud took part in the Foreign Ministers' session of the 3rd Voice of the Global South Summit chaired by External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar in the virtual format on 17 August 2024. Ambassador represented India at the inauguration ceremony of President of Comoros H.E. Mr. Azali Assoumani held in Moroni on 26 May 2024.

4. On 31 January 2026, a 3-member delegation led by Minister of Foreign Affairs of Comoros H.E. Mr. Mohamed Mbae took part in the "Second India-Arab Foreign Ministers' Meeting" held in New Delhi. On the sidelines, he joined his Arab counterparts in calling on Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. He held a bilateral meeting with Hon'ble External Affairs Minister Dr. Subrahmanyam Jaishankar and discussed bilateral cooperation in areas of health, sports, infrastructure and capacity building. On 30 January 2026, Director General of Arabic World in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Mr. Chamsoudine Said Ali and Focal Point for IORA, In-Charge for India in the

Ministry of Foreign Affairs Mr. Adelaid Ben Ali Abdou took part in "4th India-Arab Senior Officials' Meeting" held in New Delhi.

5. The then Foreign Minister of Comoros H.E. Mr. Dhoiher Dhoulkamal visited New Delhi from 1-3 March 2023 to take part in the G-20 Foreign Ministers Meeting and had a bilateral meeting with Hon'ble External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar. He also took part in the 7<sup>th</sup> Indian Ocean Conference held in Perth (Australia) on 9-10 February 2024. The then Minister of Economy and Industry of Comoros H.E. Mr. Ahmed Ali Bazi attended the G-20 Development Ministers Meeting from 11-13 June 2023 in Varanasi. Details of high level visits from Comoros to India could be seen at the Annexure.

6. Hon'ble External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar called on President Azali Assoumani on the sidelines of 77th Session of the United Nations General Assembly in New York on 20 September 2022. President Azali Assoumani appreciated India's medical assistance to Comoros in its fight against Covid-19 and dengue. They also discussed issues of cooperation in maritime security and development partnership.

7. 12 diplomats from Comoros took part in the 1st Special Course for diplomats of the Indian Ocean Region at Sushma Swaraj Institute of Foreign Service, New Delhi (SSIFS) from 20 September - 01 October 2021. One diplomat from Comoros attended the 69<sup>th</sup> Professional Course for Foreign Diplomats (PCFD) from 03-28 October 2022 at SSIFS.

8. Hon'ble EAM Dr. S. Jaishankar had a telephonic conversation with the Comorian Foreign Minister in April 2020 following which a 14 member Indian medical assistance team was sent to Comoros to help in the fight against Covid-19 and Dengue.

9. The then Vice-President of India Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu paid an official visit to Comoros from 10-12 October 2019, during which 6 MoUs were signed:

- i.* MoU on Exemption of Visa Diplomatic and Official / Service Passport Holders
- ii.* MoU on Cooperation in the Field of Arts & Culture
- iii.* MoU on Cooperation in the Field of Defence
- iv.* MoU for Cooperation in the Field of Health & Medicine
- v.* Protocol for Consultations between India and Comoros

vi. MoU for Participation in the e-VBAB Network Project

Following announcements for grants were also made during the visit of the Hon'ble Vice-President of India to Comoros:

- i. Medicines and medical equipment worth US\$ 1 mn.
- ii. Transport vehicles worth US\$ 1 mn
- iii. Interceptor Boats worth US\$ 2 mn
- iv. Supply of 1000 MT of rice. (*Delivered in March 2021 during the visit of INS Jalashwa to Comoros. Foreign Minister Dhoihir Dhoulkamal received the consignment on behalf of Govt. of Comoros.*)

10. President of the Union of Comoros, H.E. Mr. Azali Assoumani led a Comorian delegation to participate in the Founding Conference of the International Solar Alliance in New Delhi in March 2018.

11. The then Minister of State for Science & Technology, H.E. Mr. Y.S. Chowdhary visited Comoros as Special Envoy of the Prime Minister of India in August 2015.

### **Trade-Economic Cooperation**

12. Comoros as one of the Least Developed Countries, benefits from Gol's Duty Free Tariff Preference scheme since April 2008. The total export and import figures of India with respect to Comoros for the last five years are given below:

13. Major imports of India from Comoros are cloves, iron and steel, copper, aluminum etc. and major exports from India to Comoros are rice, meat, cotton, sugar, textiles etc.

## **Developmental Partnership**

14. The Charge d'Affaires handed over 06 pickup vans and 06 ambulances to Chief of Staff to the Presidency in charge of Defense H.E. Mr. Youssef Mohamed Ali, in Moroni (Comoros) on 25 March 2026.

15. Interim Secretary General of Minister of Foreign Affairs of Comoros Mr. Abdourahamani Said Bakari and Secretary General of the Ministry of Youth, Sports, Employment, Arts and Culture Mr. Kaissane Hassane took part in celebrations of "ITEC Day 2025-26" organized by Embassy in Moroni on 24 March 2026. Secretary General of Ministry of National Education Mr. Said Soule and Secretary General of Ministry of Youth and Sports Mr. Ibrahim Mahamoud took part in the "ITEC Day" celebrations organized by the Embassy in Moroni on 24 March 2025.

16. Director of the National Herbarium Dr Andilyat Mohamed took part in second WHO Traditional Medicine Global Summit held in New Delhi from 17-19 December 2025. Head of Maritime Safety and Security Department took part in 3rd edition of Maritime Information Sharing Workshop (MISW) held in Gurugram from 03-05 November 2025. Head of Economy, Finance and Banking Department at the Secretariat General of Comoros took part in "Quad Ports of the Future Partnership - A Quad Initiative", held in Mumbai from 29-30 October 2025. One official from the National Agency for Medicines and Medical Evacuations (ANAMEV) and one official from the Ministry of Health took part in 2nd edition of the Policymakers' Forum on Indian Pharmacopoeia, held in India (New Delhi/Ahmedabad) from 16-19 June 2025. One diplomat from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Comoros took part in the 1st Special Course for the Diplomats of IORA countries conducted by the Sushma Swaraj Institute of Foreign Service in New Delhi from 28 April- 3 May 2025. Two officials from the Ministry of Finance of Comoros attended the ITEC Executive programme "Global Trends in Building Infrastructure for Development" held at IIM Indore from 28 April – 11 May 2024. Two officials from the Directorate General of Civil Security (DGCS) of Comoros took part in a Workshop titled "Strengthening Capacity of Power Sector Practitioners in the Indo-Pacific Region" organized at CDRI, New Delhi from 4 -7 June 2024, under the initiative of Quad Infrastructure Coordination Group.

17. India offers a number of ITEC slots and ICCR scholarships to Comoros under its developmental partnership. As on date, total slots availed by Comoros are:

- i. ICCR: 68
- ii. ITEC: 106
- iii. IAFS-III: 29
- iv. Ilearn portal: 2

18. In December 2012, Government of India provided US\$ 100,000 as assistance to Comoros for losses suffered on account of torrential rains in April 2012.

19. Indian Coast Guard Ship "Saksham" was anchored off the Moroni Port on an overseas deployment from 23-26 March 2025 during which the personnel of the Indian and the Comorian Coast Guards held professional interactions and joint trainings.

20. In response to the requests received from the Government of Comoros for supply of medicines to deal with situation of Dengue and Covid-19, a 14-member Indian Medical Assistance Team visited Comoros on board INS Kesari from 1-18 June 2020. A consignment of medicines as relief assistance was also donated to Comoros. India donated Anti TB Drugs to Comoros in July 2022 under NTEP (National Tuberculosis Elimination Program).

21. INS Jalashwa visited the port of Anjouan in Comoros from 14-18 March 2021 to deliver 1000 MT of rice in fulfilment of the announcement of donation of rice made during the visit of the Hon'ble Vice-President of India to Comoros in Oct 2019. The consignment of rice was received by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Comoros, H.E. Mr. Dhoiher Dhoulkamal.

22. EXIM Bank of India had offered a concessional credit of US\$41.6 million for setting up a heavy fuel oil power plant in Moroni in 2015. A joint venture of "Overseas Infrastructure Alliance" and BHEL was awarded the contract for implementation of the project.

## **Culture**

23. An Indian Contemporary Dance Group sponsored by the Indian Council of Cultural Relations (ICCR) performed at the Comorian National Assembly Hall in Moroni on 28 August 2018. The event was attended by the President Comoros, First Lady, Foreign Minister, Speaker of the National Assembly and other dignitaries. One Comorian national participated in Kumbh Mela

celebrations in India in March 2019. 12 artists from Comoros took part in the Surajkund International Crafts Mela in Haryana from 2-18 February 2024. 10th International Day of Yoga was celebrated in Moroni on 14 June 2024. A 20-member cultural troupe from Comoros took part in the 38th Surajkund International Crafts Mela held in Surajkund (Haryana) from 7-23 February 2025. 11th International Day of Yoga was celebrated in Moroni on 17 June 2025. A 20-member cultural troupe from Comoros took part in the 39<sup>th</sup> Surajkund International Crafts Mela held in Surajkund (Haryana) from 31 January-15 February 2026.

### **Indian Diaspora**

24. The Indian Diaspora comprises of around 250 persons and most of them are engaged in trading, business and other professions. Their role in the economic development of Comoros is well appreciated.
